

Item 6. CONSIDER PURCHASING OUTRIGHT THE TWO CHEVROLET CAPRICES FROM HUDIBURG AUTO GROUP TO BE USED FOR POLICE CARS.

Information: Hudiburg Auto Group presented a proposal to the Town of Arcadia. The two autos could be leased for a price of \$69,204.00 for both for a period of 36, 48, or 60 months. If the autos are purchased outright, the town could realize a savings in interest of no less than \$5,876.00. Reserve Account does have enough funds to cover purchasing the autos outright.

Board Inquiries: 1) How does purchasing the autos outright affect the warranties; 2) how many miles do the warranties cover; 3) what equipment is transferrable from existing police cars to the new ones under the quoted prices(s); and 4) what is the approximate cost to transfer and install radar, video camera and video recording equipment.

Action Required: **Motion** to approve purchasing autos outright and using funds from the Reserve Account for the purchase.

Item 7. CONSIDER LEASING A PORTION (approximately 15 feet) OF KIESLING STREET TO SAEED AHADIZADEH TO ACCOMMODATE THE OUTPUT (chlorinated wastewater) FROM THE SEPTIC TANK.

Information: Mr. Ahadizadeh property is located at 405 NE 8th Street and Kiesling Street which is not open at present time abuts the property and is immediately West of it. He is planning to install a new septic system. However, the property does not have enough space to install the system. He is requesting that the Arcadia Board of Trustees consider leasing a portion of Kiesling Street to him so enough land would be available for the system. All components of the system will be on his land. However, two of the system's heads will be immediately adjacent to Kiesling Street and about another 15 feet is needed for the heads to properly spray odorless chlorinated wastewater into the grassy area.

Action Needed: **Motion** to consider approving a year-to-year lease agreement with Mr. Ahadizadeh to lease about 15 feet of Kiesling Street in order to install a septic system, with the understanding that once the town's sewer is installed, the lease automatically becomes null and void. Also, approval would be contingent upon proper plans being submitted to the town, a review of the lease proposal by town's legal counsel and final negotiations of a lease agreement.
